RESIDENT CAMPS

SENIOR HIGH CAMP

Teens entering grades 9-12 can take advantage of Judson's Senior High Week. This is a camp where individuals can explore spiritual issues in greater depth and enjoy contemporary worship music at vespers. During the week campers select activities, play fun challenging games, and make friendships that can last a lifetime.



JUNIOR HIGH CAMP

Exciting challenges and new friendships are just two features of Junior High Camp at Judson. Pre-teens entering grades 7 and 8 are encouraged to develop their skills while enjoying the camping experience. It's a great chance to have some summer fun.



JUNIOR CAMP

Junior Camp at Judson is packed with fun adventures, games, and activities. Students entering grades 4, 5, and 6 can enjoy the outdoors, and may choose three of our resident camp electives to accompany their daily Bible studies.

MINI CAMP

This is a great time for students entering grades 2 and 3 to attend a 3 day camp. Come make new friends and discover Camp Judson! Mini camps run from 3PM on Sunday to 10AM on Wednesday or 3PM on Wednesday to 10AM on Saturday. (Registering for consecutive Mini Camps is not recommended.)

RESIDENT SPECIALTY CAMPS

WRANGLER CAMP 1 & 2 -For Grades 9 -12

This week is for the camper who is serious about horsemanship and wants to devote most of the day to learning about, and working with, horses. Specialized instruction takes you through the basics of proper horse care, horse anatomy, and riding skills. Those who complete this challenge attain a good understanding of the wrangler's job. There is also time built into the schedule for Bible study, swimming, and other camp related activities.



ADVENTURES IN ARCHEOLOGY –For Grades 7-12

This session provides an exciting introduction to archaeology through hands on activities, including excavation of a real dig site at Judson and various adventure challenges. The week will focus on using teamwork and critical thinking to better understand the past.

ARTS ALIVE IN 2010 –For Grades 7-12

Campers will have the opportunity to discover and use their artistic gifts (musical– instrumental and vocal, visual arts, photography, dance, ect.) to enhance their personal relationship with Christ. They will also be encouraged to use this camp as a steppingstone to help them use their talent as a witness to others!

LET'S TALK DOLLARS

The fees for camping programs pay only a portion of the total cost. The mission dollars given through your church help to subsidize and maintain your camping facility.

Camp scholarship funds are available. Camp Judson keeps rates as low as possible, but if the cost is discouraging you, we suggest that you apply for C.A.P. (Camper Assistance Program) which is made possible by the friends of camp. All scholarship recipients are required to pay a portion of the registration, which needs to be included with your registration form in order for the camp registrar to register you for your week of camp. Please call the office to obtain a C.A.P. form.

TRAILBLAZERS –For Grades 7-12

JR TRAILBLAZERS –For Grades 4-6

Life out of doors is the essence of Trailblazers. It is the perfect camp session for those who feel at home playing, learning, and sleeping in the midst of God's creation. Hiking, canoeing, fishing, developing camping skills, sharing and singing around the fire, and even more await to challenge the adventurous camper. This unique atmosphere promotes group cooperation and ultimately, a deeper appreciation of God and His creations.

JR/SR HIGH SUMMER BLAST –For Grades 7-12

This is a 3-day camp open to junior and senior high students who are unable to attend a full week at Camp Judson. Summer Blast breaks away from some of the regular camp routines yet also offers a lot of your old favorites. It is a week of challenges and fun packed into just 3 days!



DAY CAMP –For Grades K-6

We offer two weeks of fun filled Day Camp! We begin at 9AM and conclude at 3PM each day. Campers in the elementary grades sign up for one week or more if desired. Campers are asked to bring their own lunches (that are kept cold until lunchtime) and Judson will provide snacks and a beverage each day.

ELECTIVES FOR RESIDENT CAMP

Resident campers have an opportunity to have instruction in **three** of these nine achievement areas.

Mini campers will do the following electives: horses, climbing wall, canoeing, swimming.

CANOEING

Campers choosing this elective learn how to handle a canoe properly. Training takes place on the pond and certificates can be earned with experience. Water battles and canoe races are all part of the fun.

SWIMMING

All swimming classes are taught by Red Cross Water Safety Instructors. Certification cards are earned by completing 7 levels of skill tests. Campers learn basic water safety and master different strokes. There's no better place to be on a hot summer day than in the pool at Camp Judson!

ARCHERY

The archery program teaches the beginner the basics along with safety, while the experienced bowman will have a chance to refine their skills. Pins are awarded to those accomplishing the various skill levels.

ROCK CLIMBING, RAPPELLING AND THE ZIPLINE

Safely learn the skills of rock climbing and rappelling on our 40 ft. climbing tower. Also, you'll have a chance to experience the thrill of the zip line. Put some adventure and a great sense of accomplishment into your week at camp with this elective.

SAILING

The sailing program at Judson is for beginners as well as experienced sailors. Novice sailors learn the basics of sailing on the pond, while intermediate and advanced students apply the skills they have already acquired to the challenge of sailing on Lake Erie. It's a great way to experience Judson's beautiful waterfront.

SPORTS

This elective is a great choice for anyone who enjoys participation sports. The focus is on developing teamwork and good sportsmanship, plus learning basic rules and techniques for a variety of games. Soccer, football, softball and baseball may be just a few of the sports you can participate in during your week at camp.

CRAFTS

This is a great elective for campers who like to work with their hands and make neat "stuff". During your week you'll have a chance to make the traditional crafts and also the latest trends. Campers can make a variety of useful and decorative items to take home.

HORSEMANSHIP

If you like to learn about horses, this is for you! You begin by learning the basics of grooming and riding, and may continue to work on CHA certification in horsemanship. Trail rides and daily classes make this elective a fun opportunity to work with our friends on four legs.

WATER SPORTS

A natural choice for those who love playing in the water. Our water sports elective focuses on enjoying the games of water volleyball, basketball, and water polo. Tubing with the jet ski on the lake is also offered as the weather permits.

OUTDOOR DISCOVERY

An elective that encourages campers to explore the various natural resources at Camp Judson, with an emphasis in ecology and good stewardship of the earth God provided us with. Whether it's walking the trails or walking along the shores of Lake Erie campers will benefit from this exciting outdoor activity.

5. The required registration deposit is \$80.00 for Resident and Adventure Camps and \$40.00 for Mini Camps. The deposit for Day Camp is \$25.00. Applying for C.A.P., we ask that the Parent/Guardian pay the deposit fee.
6. Each camper can earn \$20 off their registration by inviting a camper who has never been to Judson summer camp. The new camper will also earn \$20 off their registration fee. There is a line on the registration form to enter the name of the camper who invited the new camper.
7. One half of the deposit fee is refundable up to two (2) weeks before camp. **Less THAN TWO (2) WEEKS — NO REFUNDS!**
